

Privacy Policy

Pacific Island Navigation Limited trading as SeaTheShips (“We”, “Us” and “Our”), take your privacy seriously and commit ourselves to protecting and respecting your privacy when visiting and using Our website (www.seatheships.org.uk). This privacy policy describes how and why We obtain, store and process data which can identify you.

For the purposes of the Data Protection Act 1998 (the “Act”), the identity of Our data controller shall be available upon enquiry by telephone or email (see below for contact details).

How and why do we collect information?

We may ask you to submit information by registering to use Our website and logging in to Our website]. This information is required to enable you to use Our website.

What Information may we collect from you?

Any personal information We collect from Our website or otherwise will be used in accordance with the Act and other applicable laws.

We collect information about you for 2 reasons: first, to attribute any comments or photographs you put on the Our website, and secondly, to improve the service we provide to you.

The type of information We will collect about you includes two primary things:

- Your “Username”
- email address;
- if you contact Us, We may keep a record of that correspondence.

How we store your IP address and cookies?

In order to help Us understand how visitors to Our website use it and to assist Us in introducing changes and improvements to it, We collect IP addresses and, if your web browser is set up to accept them, We use a feature known as a "cookie". Cookies contain bits of information that websites transfer to your computer's hard drive for record keeping purposes. Cookies can make the internet more useful by storing information about your preferences on a particular site such as Ours.

We use cookies for the following principal purposes:

- to access your previously stored information;
- to estimate Our audience size and usage patterns; and
- to assist Us in targeting page content and possibly in the future, advertisements.

The internet browsers on most computers are usually set to accept cookies. You can choose to disable this through your browser's settings; you can also delete cookies that are already stored in the cookie folder on your computer. If you opt to disable persistent cookies on your browser, your experience of Our website may be less enjoyable, as suggested information may not be as relevant to you.

Where will personal information about you be stored?

The information that you provide to Us will be transferred to and stored by Us. By supplying such information, you consent to this transfer and storage.

Keeping information about you secure is very important to Us and certain sections of Our website may encrypt data. However, no data transmission over the Internet can be

guaranteed to be totally secure. As a result, We cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information which you send to Us, and you do so at your own risk.

How will personal information about you be used by us?

Personal information may be used for one or more of the following purposes:

- to improve the content of Our website;
- to notify you of changes to the services We offer.
- to customise the content and/or layout of Our website pages for an individual visitor;
- to notify visitors about updates to Our website; and
- to support your relationship with Us.
